

UPDATE OF PRODUCTS SOLD IN THE CAFETERIA SEP 2025-2026 Guideline Alignment (February 2026)

To fully comply with the Ministry of Education guidelines, and per the Office of the Head of School, some changes were made to the products sold at the cafeteria.

MAIN CHANGES

Candy and snacks

- Reduced from 35 to 10 approved items
- Reduced portion sizes and switched to approved school packaging

Drinks

- No more sodas
- Reduced presentations over 600 ml
- New beverage options without nutrition advisory stamps

Operating hours

- Snacks only available during recess
- Only healthy options during the After-School Program

New healthy options

- Mixed berry parfait, sushi, lentil tabbouleh, salads, homemade popcorn, mini pancakes, fresh fruit, and shredded vegetables
