From December 1–5, 2026, a group of 7th and 8th grade students will have the opportunity to attend the Global Games in Florida, USA. This experience combines sports activities, cultural exchange, and many exciting opportunities to connect with students from Nord Anglia Education sister schools across the Americas.

At Eton School Mexico, we believe in providing opportunities that reflect both our academic expectations and the values that define our community. As participants represent not only themselves but also our school, students must meet a set of eligibility criteria related to academic performance, behavior, personal responsibility, and engagement.

To be considered for participation, students must meet the following criteria:

SOCIAL AND EMOTIONAL DEVELOPMENT

Students should demonstrate positive behavior and citizenship and must not have any major disciplinary reports.

The participant:

- Interacts positively and respectfully with peers.
- Demonstrates a cooperative attitude.
- Shows respect toward others and the school community.
- Demonstrates self-control and responsible decision-making.
- Acts with integrity and takes responsibility for their actions.
- Follows school rules and procedures.
- Follows instructions appropriately.
- Demonstrates organizational skills and personal responsibility.

ACADEMIC PERFORMANCE

- MAP results in Reading and Mathematics must be at or above grade level.
- Students must not have any failing subjects.

ENGAGEMENT IN SPORTS

- Students consistently participate with enthusiasm and a positive attitude in sports activities, whether during Physical Education classes or in the After School Program.

IMPORTANT NOTE

Nord Anglia Education also offers opportunities to participate in the Performing Arts Festival and the STEAM Festival. If your child is more inclined toward artistic or STEAM-related experiences, please note that students may participate in only **one** NAE regional event during the school year: either the Global Games, the Performing Arts Festival, or the STEAM Festival.
